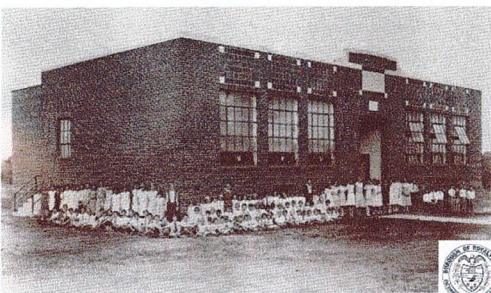

We can't wait to see what you might have to be preserved for future generations.

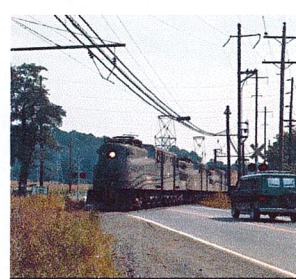

AUGUST RECIPE REFRIGERATOR PICKLES



Ingredients

6 cups thinly sliced cucumbers

2 cups thinly sliced onions

1½ cups sugar

1½ cups cider vinegar

½ teaspoon salt

½ teaspoon mustard seed

½ teaspoon celery seed

½ teaspoon ground turmeric

½ teaspoon ground cloves

Directions

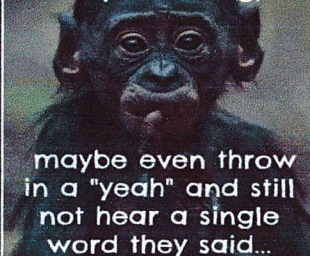
Place cucumbers and onions in a large bowl; set aside. Combine remaining ingredients in a saucepan; bring to a boil. Cook and stir just until sugar is dissolved. Pour over cucumber mixture; cool. Cover tightly and refrigerate for at least 24 hours before serving.

This is the basic recipe but you can change it up with spices you might prefer. Some might want to change the cloves to red pepper flakes to give your pickles a little kick.

Best way to cut your cucumbers is to use a Mandoline. This kitchen tool makes quick work of cutting the cucumbers and onions.
