Swarmed is a free public resource that connects you with local beekeepers to safely relocate honey bees.

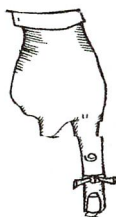
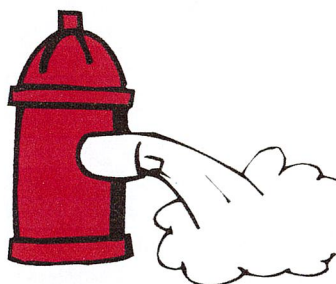
Protecting bees

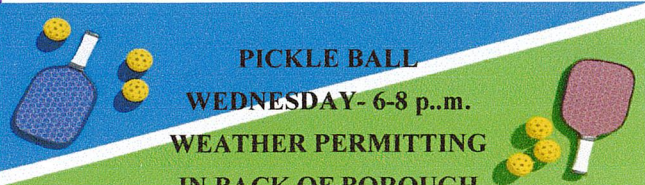

AUGUST RECIPE

YUMMY NO-BAKE BARS



Ingredients

- 1- cup granulated sugar
- 1- cup light corn syrup
- 2- cups peanut butter
- 3- cups rice krispies
- 3-cups cornflakes
- 1¼- cups butter
- 4- cups powdered sugar
- 2- 4 serving size packages of instant vanilla pudding
- ¼- cup milk
- 1- 12 ounce package semisweet chocolate bits

Directions

Line a 15x10x1 inch baking pan with foil, extending foil over the edges of the pan. Set aside.

In a large saucepan combine the granulated sugar and corn syrup. Heat and stir just until mixture bubbles around the edge of pan. Heat and stir for 1 minute more. Remove from heat. Stir in peanut butter until melted. Stir in rice krispies and cornflakes until coated. Press mixture evenly into the bottom of the foil lined pan.

For pudding layer, in a medium saucepan, melt ¾ cup of the butter on medium heat. Remove pan from heat. Stir in powdered sugar, dry pudding mixes and milk. Spread pudding mixture over cereal layer; set aside.

For frosting, in a small saucepan combine chocolate bits and the remaining ½ cup butter. Heat and stir on low heat until melted. Spread frosting evenly over the pudding layer. Cover and chill until set. Use the foil to lift bars from pan. Cut into bars.
